Here is a basic outline that you can follow to help write an award-winning essay.

- 1. Introductory Sentence
  - a. State your full-name
  - b. State the name of the scholarship you are applying for.
- 2. Educational Objectives & Goals
  - a. State your major & why you selected it
  - b. State future goals
- 3. Brief Background
  - a. Tell about yourself
  - b. Give specific examples of your character
  - c. Highlight your interests including volunteer work & experience
- 4. Need
  - a. State why you need this scholarship
  - b. State how this scholarship will help you.
- 5. Conclusion
  - a. Highlight an item or two from your essay.
  - b. Thank the judges (optional)

## Formatting Your Scholarship Essay

A scholarship essay is typically

- Font-sized 12;
- In Times New Roman;
- Double spaced;
- With one-inch margins on all sides of the paper; and
- Printed on A4-sized bond papers.

Follow all this, of course, unless the scholarship program you are applying to specifies a certain set of formatting guidelines.
